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Multi-utility diversion works and reinstatement at The Moor and Eyre Street, Sheffield

As part of Sheffield City Council's regeneration programme, the Moor project comprised the demolition of existing 1960's shops to make way for a state of the art shopping mall.



SCD is an experienced contractor having performed civil engineering works with the main utility companies.

Prior to the main structural engineering development of The Moor Shopping Centre all the main telecommunications and utility services had to be diverted.

SCD created a common utility corridor infrastructure and installed ducting, pipework and electrical cables ready for individual utility connections.

All subsequent re-statement was in line with the overall scheme design.
